



BARTEL FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (Grades 1-8)



The Bartel Family and Saint Andrew the Apostle School are committed to educating young people who struggle to meet the challenges of the next millennium, and who have the potential to be successful. It is out of this determination that scholarships are made available to families of our parish community. These scholarships are available for students in grades 1st-8th and consist of monetary awards of \$200 - \$1,000 which will be applied to the recipients' tuition.

The Scholarships are awarded to young people who:

- ⊗ Demonstrate solid Christian living in the context of this community;
- ⊗ Perform academically to the best of their ability;
- ⊗ Actively participate in extra-curricular activities and/or opportunities for service or for 1st thru 3rd how they demonstrate caring for others.
- ⊗ Project a positive image of their school.

How do I apply for the Bartel Scholarship?

- ⊗ Apply on-line to FACTS Grant & Aid. If you are a new or returning family, you must either follow this link: <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3D8S9>, or type <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3D8S9> in your internet browser. If you are a current family, you will have a user name and password since we use FACTS as our tuition management company. If you are a new family, you will need to create a new account. Remember, you must reapply every year.
- ⊗ Complete a one-page essay describing your current involvement in various activities and what goals you hope to achieve at St. Andrew the Apostle. Please note that young people enrolled in grades 1st -3rd may have their parent's assistance in preparing their written presentation.
- ⊗ **For all new students** in 1st-8th grade, we will need a copy of your last report card.
- ⊗ A referral from one teacher.
(All requests for teacher referrals must be made in writing one week before you need it, and the teacher must have had your child in their class within the last two years.)
- ⊗ The essay, the report card (if you are new student), the teacher referral and this application should be received **no later than March 1st** mail to: Bartel Scholarship, 530 Glen Avenue, Romeoville, IL 60446.

What happens after I turn in my application?

We will review your application. After all materials have been reviewed and evaluated, you will be notified of the outcome of your application.

How does St. Andrew the Apostle determine who receives these scholarships?

Recipients will be chosen based on the completed applications, essays, and when applicable, most recent report card. Awards may vary depending on recommendations to the Bartel Scholarship Committee. Final scores will be based on the following criteria:
